'EUROPEAN CRIMINAL LAW AND ITS IMPACT ON NATIONAL LEGAL ORDERS'

The working language of the conference will be English.

We wish to invite scholars and practising lawyers who are involved in Comparative and European Criminal Law and Criminal Justice to make presentations. More specifically, we would like to use the Conference as an opportunity and forum for discussion and exchange of views on the impact of European criminal law on national legal orders. First, we would like to focus attention on the implementation of the European Union *acquis* into the national legal orders of the Member States in theory and practice. Secondly, we wish to concentrate on the standards adopted within the Council of Europe, with a view to further comparative study. Contributions may be published in the post-conference proceedings.
